## **AUTUMN SCHEDULE**

These sessions are aimed at social workers, healthcare practitioners and team managers in the public, voluntary and independent sectors.

### **Thursday 30th September**

#### **Safeguarding Vulnerable Adults and Managing Risk**

This workshop explores the challenges faced by key individuals in spotting the potential indicators of abuse and taking appropriate and timely action to reduce risk.

### **Thursday 28th October**

#### **Safeguarding Vulnerable Adults: Understanding Non-criminal Investigation**

This workshop looks at the process for investigating concerns about likely harm to vulnerable people and explores a systematic process for gathering information and making evidence-based judgements, leading to the formulation of protection plans.

### **Thursday 25th November**

#### **Developing an Effective Safeguarding Plan**

This workshop explores the expectations of victims in relation to future safety. It uses case-studies to explore options and choices and considers possible arrangements to manage future protection.
